



4. **Depositions:** The parties may depose each named party plus 5 additional depositions, to be completed by the close of discovery on February 9, 2016. The parties may take more depositions by mutual agreement or may move the court for more with a showing of good cause.
5. **Written Discovery:** The standard allotment for written discovery, i.e., 15, will be maintained, as will the standard response time of 30 days.
6. **Expert Reports:** Plaintiffs shall disclose all expert reports by November 2, 2015; Defendants shall disclose all expert reports by November 30, 2015.
7. **Motions:** Defendants have indicated that they intend to move for abstention based on similar state court proceedings; that motion shall be filed by November 9, 2015, and Plaintiffs shall file their response by November 18, 2015. Summary judgment motions shall be filed by February 23, 2016; responses to summary judgment motions shall be due within 10 days of service.
8. **Preliminary Injunction:** Plaintiffs have moved for a preliminary injunction. Defendants' response must be filed by November 10, 2015. Plaintiffs' reply must be filed by November 18, 2015. Hearing on the preliminary

injunction is set for Monday, November 23, 2015.

9. **Trial:** The bench trial for this matter shall commence on April 11, 2016.

10. **Mediation.** The case is exempted from the district's mandatory mediation provisions.
