
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**ORDER**

It has come to the attention of the Court that the above named plaintiff, RON CEASAR, has been previously sanctioned and barred by the Western District of Louisiana. In 2:99cv933, the plaintiff's In Forma Pauperis status was revoked by Judge Trimble, absent a showing of good cause. Further, in 6:04cv00391, the defendant was barred from filing any further litigation in the Western District of Louisiana until all costs and fees in that matter were paid. The Court has been offered no evidence that such action has taken place.

Due to a clerical error, the instant case has proceeded to this point. It should not have. Mr. Ceasar has not offered proof of full payment of the outstanding fees and costs referenced above. Further, he has failed to offer good cause for proceeding In Forma Pauperis, as is required by Judge Trimble. Consequently, the Order (Doc. #3) granting IFP status is hereby **STRICKEN** and the request for same is **DENIED**. As such, the case is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
