DISTRICT 2. ERIE COUNTY.

Part of ERIE COUNTY consisting of the CITY of Erie (Part, Wards 5 and 6). Population 60,266.

DISTRICT 3. ERIE COUNTY.

Part of ERIE COUNTY consisting of the CITY of Erie (Part, Ward 3), and the TOWNSHIP of Millcreek. Population 61,992.

DISTRICT 4. ERIE COUNTY.

Part of ERIE COUNTY consisting of the CITY of Erie (part, Wards 1, 2, and 4), and the TOWNSHIPS of Greene, Harborcreek, and Lawrence Park and the BOROUGH of Wesleyville. Population 62,306.

DISTRICT 5. CHESTER COUNTY.

Part of CHESTER COUNTY consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of East Brandywine, East Nantmeal, Honey Brook, Upper Uwchlan, Wallace, Warwick, West Bradnywine, West Caln, West Nantmeal, and West Vincent and the BOROUGHS of Elverson and Honey Brook. Population 63,205.

DISTRICT 6. CRAWFORD and ERIE COUNTIES.

Part of CRAWFORD COUNTY consisting of the CITY of Meadville, the TOWNSHIPS of Athens, Bloomfield, Cambridge, East Mead, Richmond, Rockdale, Rome, Sparta, Venango, West Mead, and Woodcock, and the BOROUGHS of Blooming Valley, Cambridge Springs, Conneaut Lake, Saegertown, Spartansburg, Venango, and Woodcock, and Part of ERIE County consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Conneaut, Elk Creek, Franklin, and Washington and the BOROUGHS of Albion, Edinboro, and Platea. Population 61,528.

DISTRICT 7. MERCER COUNTY.

Part of MERCER COUNTY consisting of CITIES of Farrell, Hermitage, and Sharon, the TOWNSHIPS of Delaware, East Lackawannock, Jefferson, Lackawannock, Pymatuning, Shenango, South Pymatuning, and Wilmington, and the

BOROUGHS of Clark, Fredonia, Mercer, Sharpsville, West Middlesex, and Wheatland. Population 64,258.

DISTRICT 8. BUTLER and MERCER COUNTIES

Part of BUTLER COUNTY consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Franklin, Muddycreek, Slippery Rock, and Worth, the BOROUGHS of Portersville, Prospect, Slippery Rock and West Liberty and part of MERCER county, consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Coolspring, Deer Creek, Fairview, Findley, French Creek, Jackson, Lake, Liberty, New Vernon, Otter Creek, Perry, Pine, Salem, Sandy Creek, Sandy Lake, Springfield, Wolf Creek and Worth, and the BOROUGHS of Grove City, Jackson Center, Mill Creek, New Lebanon, Sandy Lake, Sheakleyville, and Stoneboro. Population 62,987.

DISTRICT 9. LAWRENCE COUNTY.

DISTRICT 10. BEAVER and LAWRENCE COUNTIES.

Part of BEAVER COUNTY consisting of the CITY of Beaver Falls, the TOWNSHIPS of Franklin, Marion, North Sewickley, Rochester, and White, and the BOROUGHS of Eastvale, Fallston, Koppel, New Brighton, and Patterson Heights, and Part of LAWRENCE County consisting of the TOWNSHIPS of Hickory, Little Beaver, Perry, Plain Grove, Scott, Slippery Rock, Washington, and Wayne, and the BOROUGHS of Ellport, Ellwood City, Enon Valley, New Beaver, Volant, and Wampum. Population 63,540.

DISTRICT 11. BUTLER COUNTY.

City, and Part of MONTGOMERY COUNTY consisting of the BOROUGH of Pottstown. Population 62,377.

DISTRICT 27. ALLEGHENY COUNTY
