
It is therefore ORDERED that the following motions are DENIED as moot: Steve Munisteri's Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. # 11); Defendants' Motion to Dismiss and for Judgment on the Pleadings (Dkt. # 40); Defendants' Motion for Summary Judgment (Dkt. # 56); and Defendants' Motion to Dismiss (Dkt. # 183).

It is further ORDERED that the parties confer and submit a proposed form of judgment or dismissal order to the Court on or before Wednesday, July 31, 2013. Pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 54(d)(2) and W.D. Tex. Rule CV-7(j), all applications for attorneys fees and costs shall be filed no later than twenty days after entry of the final judgment or dismissal order. If the application is opposed in whole

or in part, a response in opposition shall be filed no later than ten days after the filing of the application.

The Court will rule on the applications for attorneys fees and expenses at its earliest convenience, and the case will be closed thereafter.
