The following are before the Court:

1. **PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS BY WISCONSIN STATE ASSEMBLY SPEAKER ROBIN J. VOS**, filed on May 10, 2019, by counsel for the petitioner.
2. **WISCONSIN STATE ASSEMBLY SPEAKER ROBIN J. VOS'S EMERGENCY MOTION FOR STAY PENDING DISPOSITION OF PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS**, filed on May 14, 2019, by counsel for the petitioner.
3. **PLAINTIFFS-RESPONDENTS' RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION TO PETITION FOR A WRIT OF MANDAMUS AND OPPOSITION TO EMERGENCY MOTION FOR STAY PENDING DISPOSITION OF PETITION FOR MANDAMUS**, filed on May 16, 2019, by counsel for the respondents.

4. **WISCONSIN STATE ASSEMBLY SPEAKER ROBIN J. VOS'S REPLY BRIEF IN SUPPORT OF EMERGENCY MOTION FOR STAY PENDING DISPOSITION OF PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS**, filed on May 17, 2019, by counsel for the petitioner.

This court construes Robin J. Vos's petition for a writ of mandamus as a notice of appeal of the district court's order of May 3, 2019, in case no. 3:15-cv-421-jdp in the District Court for the Western District of Wisconsin. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the clerk of this court shall **TRANSFER** the petition to the district court to be docketed as a notice of appeal.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that proceedings in the appeal are **STAYED** pending the Supreme Court's resolution of *Rucho v. Common Cause*, No. 18-422, and *Lamone v. Benisek*, No. 18-726. The parties shall file statements of position no later than seven days after the Supreme Court has issued its decisions in *Rucho* and *Lamone*.

IT IS FINALLY ORDERED that the district court's order of May 3, 2019, is **STAYED** pending resolution of the appeal.
