

ADDENDUM TO OBJECTIONS

Case No. 3:25-cv-01273-SVN

Plaintiff, Scott A. Ingersoll, pro se, submits this addendum to support the Objections to the Report and Recommendation (Doc #16), providing evidence of economic harm from the Clean Energy Future Act (CEFA) and 2020 congressional maps.

1. **Eversource Residential Electric Rates (2020–2025):**

- Jan–Jun 2020: 14.9¢/kWh (\$104/month for 700 kWh).
- Jan–Jun 2023: 32.7¢/kWh (\$229/month, +100% supply, +41% total).
- Jan–Jun 2025: 20.4¢/kWh (\$143/month, +32% cumulative since 2020).
- Jul–Dec 2025 (projected): 18.9¢/kWh (\$132/month).
- Source: PURA Dockets (e.g., 25-01-03), OCC Alerts (Jan 2025), Eversource Filings (Nov 2024, May 2025), EIA Data.

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2. **Impact Analysis:**

- Cumulative rise: 32% (\$40/month, \$480/year) for 700 kWh users.
- 2023 Spike: +\$88/month due to CEFA, Millstone contracts, and gas prices.
- 2024 SBC Jump: +\$48/month from low-income subsidies and EV mandates.
- Plaintiff's Claim: Aligns with a \$300-to-\$700/month jump and \$22,000 debt over 3–4 years, supported by attached bills (Jan 2023: \$821.64, Jan 2025: \$1,006.52, Sep 2024: \$532.69, Sep 2025: \$287.19).

3. **PURA Mismanagement and Resignation:**

- Marissa Gillett, PURA chair (2015–2025), resigned October 10, 2025, amid alleged perjury in her 2025 confirmation hearing (Rep. Vincent J. Candelora letter, September 18, 2025, to Speaker Matt Ritter). Plaintiff is seeking this letter from Candelora's office (860-240-8700) and will submit it if obtained. Lawsuits from Eversource and Avangrid (ctmirror.org, October 28, 2025) cite her mismanagement as exacerbating rate hikes during her tenure, overlapping CEFA implementation (July 2023). The 5-0 Democratic delegation, enabled by the 2020 maps, influenced PURA appointments and CEFA, driving Plaintiff's financial burden.

4. ****Request:**** Plaintiff requests this addendum be considered with the Objections, subject to amendment with personal utility records and the Candelora letter if required.

Public Benefits Charge represents a combination of three charges formerly known as: Conservation and Load Mgmt Charge, Renewable Energy Investment Charge, and Systems Benefits Charge. This charge also includes the Conservation Adjustment Mechanism approved by the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority in Docket No. 13-11-14.

**Effective January 1, 2007, the Generation Services Charge (GSC) and the Bypassable Federally Mandated Congestion Charge (BFMCC) have been combined into the "GSC Charge" listed in the Supplier Services section of your bill. The GSC reflects all of the cost of procuring energy from Eversource wholesale suppliers. The BFMCC portion of this line item is -\$0.0015 / kWh. If you multiply this BFMCC rate by the number of kWhs on your bill, you can calculate the dollar amount associated with the BFMCC.

***Electric System Improvements: Recovers company investments that protect, strengthen or modernize the electric grid.

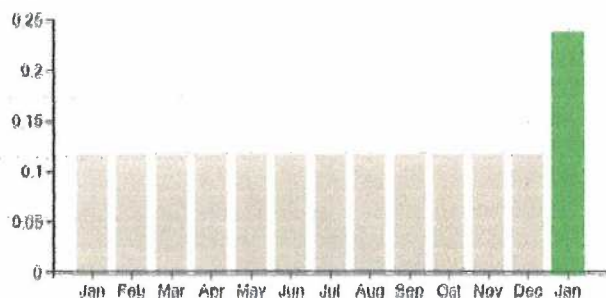
