DECLARATION OF AMY KEITH


I, Amy Keith, swear under penalty of perjury that the following information is true to the best of my knowledge and state as follows:

1. I am a resident of St. Petersburg, FL, which has been my home since 2012. I initially moved to Florida to be closer to family who also live here, and I have been living in St. Petersburg full time since March 2018.
2. I began working at Common Cause as its Florida Program Director in June 2022. In December 2023, I was promoted to Florida State Director. I serve as Florida State Director **for both Common Cause and Common Cause Education Fund (“CCEF”)** and work out of our office in St. Petersburg, FL.
3. Common Cause is a 501(c)(4) nonprofit, nonpartisan membership organization incorporated under the laws of the District of Columbia. Common Cause Education Fund is a 501(c)(3) affiliated charitable nonprofit that provides education, engagement, and research to Common Cause members, constituents, partner organizations, and the public about voting and the democratic process. CCEF works to create public engagement on democracy issues and promote effective citizen participation.
4. For purposes of this declaration, references to **“Common Cause”** include the activities and operations of both Common Cause and CCEF.
5. As Florida State Director, I supervise and recruit state staff, interns, and volunteers; develop our budget; develop policy reforms and defensive strategies at all levels of government and advocate for the passage and implementation of policies that align with **Common Cause’s mission; oversee our state Election Protection program; conduct policy research; lobby to protect democracy reform and hold elected and appointed officials accountable to their constituents; communicate with members and the public through social media, email, and other written communications; serve as Common Cause’s spokesperson in Florida to the media and government officials; and participate in civic coalitions statewide.**
6. I am authorized to speak for Common Cause in this case.
7. Common Cause is dedicated to fair elections and making government at all levels more representative, open, and responsive to the interests of ordinary people. Common Cause regularly assists voters, promotes civic participation, and advocates for democratic reforms, working to empower the public, including all Floridians, to make their voices heard in the political process.
8. Common Cause regularly works toward redistricting reform, engaging in public education, advocacy, and litigation in order to secure fair maps for all Floridians. This includes seeking to protect the interests of members to vote under lawful and constitutional voting plans that are not made with partisan intent and do not deny them equal voting power.
9. Common Cause was a primary proponent for the successful passage of the Fair Districts **Amendments (“FDA”)** in 2010 and since then, has continued to defend and enforce those protections.

10. To assist with the FDA's passage, Common Cause collected petition signatures, sent communications in support of yes votes, and otherwise publicly advocated for the FDA. Common Cause has also been involved in defending the FDA through litigation.
11. **During Florida's 2022 and 2026 congressional redistricting processes, Common Cause Florida advocated for fair redistricting that complies with the Fair Districts Amendments. The Challenged Plan nullifies these efforts and negatively affects the interests Common Cause seeks to protect in Florida, and contradicts Common Cause's mission.**
12. It was clear to me that the Challenged Map was designed with partisan intent when it was first introduced to Fox News in red and blue before it was even given to the legislature. The timing of the redistricting process, and that it was only explored after the President encouraged states to gerrymander for partisan gain, also lead me to believe the map is **partisan. Further, I was in the Senate Rules committee when the Governor's map drawer** introduced the map, and I heard him say that he used partisan data to draw the maps. Additionally, I live in Congressional District 16 within the Challenged Map. My community was cut in half without regard for community groups or geographic boundaries. Partisan gain is the only explanation I can think of for this.
13. Common Cause currently has over 50,000 members throughout all 67 counties in Florida. I am aware of **Common Cause's membership throughout Florida** because I have access to our nationally managed membership database, and because I regularly send communications to members in Florida.
