**AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND CONSOLIDATION
OF TRIAL ON COUNT I WITH PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION HEARING**

I, Giselle Anatol, declare as follows in support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction and Consolidation of Trial on Count I with Preliminary Injunction Hearing:

1. I am over the age of 18, have personal knowledge of the facts below, and can competently testify to their truth.

2. I am a registered voter at [REDACTED] Kansas City, Missouri. I have lived at this address for 20 years.

3. I currently reside in Congressional District 5 under the 2022 Map.

4. Under the 2025 map as set out in House Bill 1, I will be drawn into Congressional District 4, which also includes Pulaski and Webster Counties. Some parts of Pulaski and Webster Counties are more than 190 miles away from my home.

In my 25 years in Missouri, I do not recall ever having gone to either place.

5. If House Bill 1 goes into effect, my Kansas City community will be divided by the new district lines. I will no longer be within the same district as the local businesses I frequent, like Anchor Island Coffee, the Equal Minded Café, and the neighborhood barber shop I have gone to for years, all of which are on the east side of Troost Avenue and will remain in Congressional District 5.


6. Troost is at the heart of my diverse Kansas City neighborhood. My daughter attended most of elementary school at University Academy, which is just west of Troost but serves students and families across Kansas City. Children from all around the neighborhood, both east and west of Troost, play in the park near my home.

7. I moved to downtown Kansas City, and specifically to South Hyde Park, because of its proximity to Troost and because of its diversity. A mix of families of different backgrounds live on my block, and because my family is interracial, I wanted both of my children to grow up in community with people who looked like them. I think that living in the city promotes understanding and connection between people of different ethnic groups, socioeconomic statuses, and religions, in a way that I did not experience growing up in the suburbs. It is important to me that my community has a representative in Congress, like Rep. Emanuel Cleaver, who will put Kansas Citians first, and who understands Kansas City, its diverse population,

and its unique needs as the biggest city in Missouri.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.
