**AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR
PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION AND CONSOLIDATION
OF TRIAL ON COUNT I WITH PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION HEARING**

I, Mary Sapp, declare as follows in support of Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction and Consolidation of Trial on Count I with Preliminary

Injunction Hearing:

1. I am over the age of 18, have personal knowledge of the facts below, and can competently testify to their truth.

2. I am a registered voter at [REDACTED], Kansas City, Missouri, in Kansas City's South Hyde Park neighborhood. I have lived at this address since 1981.

3. I currently reside in Congressional District 5 under the 2022 Map.

4. Under the 2025 map as set out in House Bill 1, I will be drawn into Congressional District 4, which also includes Pulaski and Webster Counties. Some

parts of Pulaski and Webster Counties are more than 190 miles away from my home.

In my 75 years living in Missouri, I do not recall ever going to either place, and I believe that their needs and concerns are very different from those of my Kansas City community.

5. I have lived in Kansas City since I was five years old, and I have always lived in Congressional District 5. Representative Emanuel Cleaver has been my congressman for twenty years, and he has always been responsive to my community on local issues and has fought for us to receive federal funding.

6. If House Bill 1 goes into effect, I will no longer be in the same district as the people in the Kansas City area I consider to be my community. This includes members of my own family, all of whom currently live in Congressional District 5. Under House Bill 1, my siblings and I will be split into different districts—my brothers who live in Raytown and Gladstone will be in Congressional Districts 5 and 6, respectively, while my sister and I will be in Congressional District 4.

7. Having a unified Kansas City district is important to me because Kansas City shares local values and interests. Kansas City has a thriving LGBTQ community, which I am a part of, and has always been welcoming to me and to my partner of 32 years. Representative Cleaver has been a powerful advocate in Congress for my rights as an LGBTQ woman. He has also been an advocate for our local businesses, our museums, and affordable housing and infrastructure in Kansas

City.
