Before LOKEN, STRAS, and JUSTIN D. SMITH, Circuit Judges.

The motion for a stay pending appeal is denied because we either lack jurisdiction over the appeal or, based on the briefing we have so far, the stay factors have not been met. *See Nken v. Holder*, 556 U.S. 418, 425–26 (2009); *see also In re Rutledge*, 956 F.3d 1018, 1026 (8th Cir. 2020) (explaining that “we . . . ordinarily lack jurisdiction to hear an interlocutory appeal from the district court’s grant . . . of a TRO”). The motion for summary reversal is also denied, and the motion for an administrative stay is denied as moot.
