# JOINT STIPULATION VOLUNTARILY DISMISSING THIRD AMENDED COMPLAINT WITH PREJUDICE

On May 6, 2022, Plaintiffs filed their Third Amended Complaint before this Court, bringing claims against Defendants for alleged violations of the Fourteenth and Fifteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution. (ECF No. 267). Plaintiffs alleged racial gerrymandering claims (Count I) and an intentional racial discrimination claim (Count II). (ECF No. 267). On January 6, 2023, this Court unanimously ruled in favor of Plaintiffs on both claims after a nine-day trial. (ECF. No. 493). Defendants appealed that decision to the United States Supreme Court. The Court noted probable jurisdiction on May 15, 2023 and heard oral argument on October 11, 2023. On May 23, 2024, the Court issued a decision reversing this Court's decision as to Count I and remanding Count II back to this Court for further proceedings. (ECF No. 525).

Pursuant to Rule 41(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, it is hereby stipulated and agreed, by and between Plaintiffs and Defendants, through their undersigned counsel and subject to the approval of this Court, that the remaining claim, Count II, of the Third Amended Complaint is hereby DISMISSED with prejudice to the re-filing of the same. Each party shall bear its own attorneys' fees, costs, and expenses.
