I write on behalf of Wisconsin Congressmen Glenn Grothman, Bryan Steil, Tom Tiffany, Scott Fitzgerald, Derrick Van Orden, and Tony Wied and individual Wisconsin voters Gregory Hutcheson, Patrick Keller, Patrick McCalvy, and Mike Moeller, who plan to intervene in the above-referenced action, to make three brief points in response to Plaintiffs' letter filed with the Court yesterday. First, while Plaintiffs note that we have not yet moved to intervene in these proceedings, we would be happy to file such an intervention motion on any schedule this Court would prefer. Second. Plaintiffs discuss at some length the mandatory nature of Wis. Stat. § 751.035's statutory mandate, but they ultimately concede that this Court has the constitutional authority to superintend all matters in the courts of this State, just as it did in dismissing Clinard v. Brennan, No.2011XX1409 (Wis.). Third, although Plaintiffs ask this Court to send this case to an inferior 3-judge panel whose decisions can then be appealed to this Court, Plaintiffs themselves correctly told this Court just last month that because "this Court imposed the current congressional map in Johnson II, only this Court has the authority to enjoin that map or otherwise alter the order that requires Respondents to hold elections under the map." Mot. to Intervene by Wis. Bus. Leaders for Democracy at Ex.1 ¶ 16, Bothfeld v. Wis. Elections Comm'n, No.2025AP000996 (Wis. June 5, 2025).
